



2011 – 2012 Championship Supplementary Regulations

- 1) All cars must be green sheeted.
- 2) All Drivers must be members of the **JQMA** and **Speedway Australia**.
- 3) All Drivers and cars must be in the pits **1 hour** prior to Race Start.
If you arrive late you will be **ROF** (rear of field) for all heat races.
- 4) **Nominations** - (all official and correct nominations will receive 50 pts)
 - a) You may nominate for all or part of the Championship at the start of the year on the provided Nomination Form.
If you are unable to make an event that you have nominated for then you must inform the JQMV Secretary within 5 days of the race date.
Failure to do so will result in a penalty of 50 points.
 - b) Nominate 7 days prior to race date for each meeting.
Failure to do so will result in forfeiting your 50 nomination points and rear of field (ROF) penalties will be applied for all heat races within that JQMV event.
The ROF penalty will also apply in the cases of any JQMV Stand Alone events.
Nominations must be made to the Secretary via phone call, text or email.
- 5) **Weight Rule :**

120 cc Novice – 120kg
120 cc Division – 120kg
160 cc Novice – 140kg
160 cc Division – 140kg
- 6) All cars are to be scrutineered and weighed at the scrutineering area before Drivers Meeting.

- 7) The top 3 cars in all Heat Race / Feature Race are to be weighed at the Off Shoot at the completion of each Heat Race/ Feature.
Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 8) Cars will have a practice session approximately 5 minutes after the Drivers Meeting.
Any cars that are not ready will forfeit their right to hot lap (practice).
- 9) Cars will line up in Start Zone in their correct starting order.
- 10) Cars not finishing a heat will be awarded 0 points.
- 11) **Restarts**
 - : Any lap car will go to the rear.
 - : All cars must past the cone before they can overtake.
 - : If you hit the cone and it falls over you will go to the rear.
 - : If you change a tyre under a stoppage you will go to the rear. (only under a red flag)
 - : Any car judged by the Chief Steward to be the absolute and sole cause of any stoppage will go to the very rear of the field in the restart, regardless of whether the car stopped and regardless of whether other cars required a push start.(4-11-6)
 - : If the Chief Steward is unable to determine the primary cause of an incident, or judges more than one driver to be at fault, two or more cars may be sent to the rear of the field, with the car suspected of being most at fault placed at the very rear.
This is to be applied regardless of whether any particular car stopped or required a push start. (4-11-7)
 - : If the Chief Steward can determine who was at fault and who was innocent then the driver at fault will go to the rear and the innocent party will be put back into their position.

12) Chains:

Chains may be put back on under a yellow and only by an infield official if no laps have been recorded, but will go to the rear of field.

Chains that come off during a race will be sent infield, no repairs will be allowed under a closed red.

13) Passing

When a car is making a pass when he/she is up to your steering wheel you must give them racing room. (You are not to drive down into them)

If you do so you may be blacked flagged or relegated back 2 positions after the completion of the race.

14) Bumping

If you are consistently bumping the car in front you may be blacked flagged or relegated back 2 spots after the completion of the race.

15) Rain Out

If we can not run a race due to rain or heat and the JQMV chooses to reschedule the event, it will be rescheduled on 1 of the 5 rain out dates that is on the bottom of the race calendar or it will become a cancelled event.

In the event of a Rain Out JQMV Committee may amend the cut off time for nominations for rescheduling of the event or any other JQMV event if required.

If a race meeting is cancelled during an event due to rain or heat or any other matter, then if at least 2 Heat races have been ran then those points will be awarded.

If only 1 Heat race was ran then your only points awarded will be the Nomination points.

If three Heats have been completed then the awarded points will be based upon the first 2 Heats only.

If 4 Heats are run points will be awarded on all 4 Heats.

16) Misconduct

If anyone is seen to be in breach of the Code of Conduct the JQMV has the authority to suspend, remove and or apply verbal warnings resulting in penalties which may be effective immediately.
